



Research Study: Comparative Analysis of Measurement Methods of 3D Body Scans

What

Participants will have eleven body measurements manually taken three times each by up to four different measurers and have body scans taken by two different scanners using safe light waves.

Why

The purpose of the research is to generate a database of body scans of people who have also been manually measured in a controlled environment. Information collected for this research will be used to help companies consuming or using body measurements.
